Campground Rules

Welcome to Manitou Regional Park and Campground. We hope your stay with us is an enjoyable experience! In order to provide a safe and pleasant camping experience for everyone, we ask that you blease adhere to the following rules:

- ➤ Check out time is 12:00 Noon sharp. If you want to stay later than 12:00, you may pay a late check out fee of \$10.00, subject to availability.
- ➤ Pets are allowed in the Park but MUST NEVER BE LEFT IN A CAMPER OR THE SITE UNATTENDED! If you leave the Park for any reason, your pet must go as well. Barking dogs will not be tolerated. Pets must be leashed. Respect other camper's personal space. Please, clean up after your pet. Report any problems to the office, so they can be dealt with.
- ➤ Parents are responsible for the conduct and safety of their children. Please supervise younger children at the playground. Toy guns of any kind which involve projectiles are prohibited.
- ➤ Please do not walk through someone else's site. Respect their privacy.
- ➤ Please use proper camping mats which do not kill the grass. Refrain from using carpeting or rubber mats especially for extended stays.
- ➤ Campfires must be in the supplied fire pits only. Do not use outside fire pits please. Removal or repositioning of firepits or stands is prohibited. Violators will be charged \$50 (more if unit is damaged).
- ➤ Please do not bring outside wood into the Park. Firewood is available for purchase.
- ➤ The use of dirt bikes, quads or powerplants is not allowed. Also no fireworks or drones in the Park.
- ▶ Please do not park extra vehicles in empty sites. Please do not wash vehicles or RV's.
- ➤ Quiet time is 11:00 pm. All unregistered visitors must leave at this time. A night security guard and RCMP patrol the Park regularly.
- ▶ Any damage to trees, sites, Camp Kitchens or other facilities will result in a charge for payment of repairs.
- ➤ No grey water is to be drained into trees or grass.
- ➤ No persons under 18 are allowed to camp without parent or guardian.
- ➤ No under age drinking will be tolerated.
- ➤ No more than 4 unrelated people per site.
- ➤ Camp fees must be paid up at time of check-in.

Alcohol Policy

- Responsible alcohol use is permitted within the Park.
- ➤ The use of Alcohol by minors is prohibited.
- Noisy parties, loud music or disturbances will NOT BE TOLERATED. Following one warning, violators will be asked to leave the Park by security along with the RCMP. NO REFUND.
- ➤ Remember quiet time is 11:00 pm All visitors must leave at that time.

Pet Policy

- ➤ No more than 3 pets are allowed. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Virtual /electronic leashes are NOT permitted.
- ➤ You must clean up after your pet.
- ➤ Campers who own dogs with aggressive behavior will be asked to leave the Park.
- ➤ Barking dogs will not be tolerated. Never leave your dog unattended in your site, even in your trailer. Dogs tend to howl when left behind.
- ➤ Failure to comply with these rules may result in eviction from the Park. No refunds will be issued
- > Please report problem pets to the office.
